Night counselors assist the residential life coordinator in directing and supervising residential campers in the evenings, reside with the campers in the dormitory, and accompany campers to both breakfast and dinner in the dining hall. A night counselor is responsible for managing small groups of campers and serving as a role model and ambassador to the university.

- Ability to react calmly and effectively in emergency situations
